

This is the 5<sup>th</sup> consecutive year that we embarked on a ‘Pack a Hamper’ Drive in collaboration with Lam Soon CC to help the needy families in Keat Hong Zone as well as the elderly at the Evergreen Place.

Our P1 to P6 classes, with the exception of P5, “adopted” a needy family and pupils and teachers brought in a variety of food items as well as items for daily use to contribute to the needy family. Form teacher guided the pupils from the brainstorming of each family's specific needs, collection of items, to the sorting and checking of items and finally to the packing of items. On 30<sup>th</sup> May, our staff members together with volunteers from Lam Soon Youth group sent the donated items to various RCs for the needy families to pick up.

Our P5 classes started off during the I-care week with servant leadership training module which is aligned to the Evergreen Home VIA and the PBL. They came up with suggestions on activities to be carried out during the Evergreen Home visit. The pupils packed goodie bags for the old folks at Evergreen Home and some P5 pupils representing each class, led by a group of teachers, went over to visit and befriend the elderly.

Pupils and staff have a wonderful experience in exhibiting values in action and find meaning in the process of giving back to the community.
